Dictionary Project: Lion Howard Heines reports that 92 dictionaries were distributed to third-graders at LaVille Elementary School by the Lakeville Lions Club and the Lapaz Lions Club. He also reported that the Lakeville Lions Club distributed 87 dictionaries to third-graders in four private and parochial schools on the south side of South Bend, and provided 24 dictionaries to the Union Township Trustee for distribution to home-schooled children in our community.

Flea Market: The old Lakeville 84 Lumberyard on Saturday, Sunday and Monday of Labor Day Weekend, 2015, was the site of a Flea Market. Almost 30 vendors participated with many antiques and gently used items too numerous to count. Lions Club members and non-members, as well, donated hundreds of items. Scout Hall was utilized to store, sort and tag all of the donations before going to the sale. Eight tables were set up during the sale, as well as, a lot of floor space. It was a very hot and muggy time to sort, sell and pack up afterward. A vendor who participated only for a day generously gave us their leftovers so we sold and acquired more items! Thank you to each and every one of you who gave your time and effort to make the sale so successful. We raised just over \$500 thanks to all of you.

The unsold items were boxed up and are being stored for the fall sale at the United Methodist Church in October.
