It’s that time of year again—time to sign up to work for the Indiana Lions Foundation at the Indiana State Fair.


If you’ve worked before, we look forward to seeing you again.

- The Board voted to accept the transfer of Lion Dennis Clark into our club. Lion Dennis is a former Lakeville member who is transferring from the Martinsville Evening Club. Please welcome Lion Dennis.
- Lions Jennifer Gardner and Diane Fischer reported that they have done all that they can for the summer sessions of Camp Millhouse. Our club helped to clean and freshen up the décor in one of the staff cabins. Donated nightstands, dressers, lamps, curtains, shower curtains ect helped to make the cabin a more welcoming place for female staff members. The staff was also presented with toiletries, candies, jewelry and makeup to use with the campers. We will reassess needs for this cabin in the fall when we have more time to make lasting changes.
